84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Inspector Tracy Burge of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe on April 13, 2018, Officer Cierra Lane did commit the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband into/onto a State Correctional Institution, in violation of s. 944.47, Fla. Stat., when she brought methamphetamines onto the Gulf Correctional Institution Main Unit compound located in Wewahitchka, Florida.

On April 13, 2018, your Affiant received notification from Captain Bryan Tyler, Shift Supervisor at Gulf Correctional Institution Main Unit, that Officer Lane had been searched by Sergeant Joni Gainnie upon entrance to the facility. During the search, two (2) grams of a crystalline substance was found in feminine hygiene items located in Officer Lane's lunch bag. The crystalline substance was field tested and tested positive for methamphetamine.

Your Affiant conducted an interview of Captain Bryan Tyler. Captain Tyler stated the institution received a phone call early on the morning of April 13, 2018. The caller indicated Officer Lane had drugs on her possession. The caller further identified where Officer Lane had concealed the drugs. Based on the information provided, Captain Tyler retrieved Officer Lane upon her entrance to Gulf Correctional Institution Main Unit and a search was conducted of her property in the security building. Persons present during the search were Captain Tyler, Sergeant Gainnie, Lieutenant Matthew Wilson, and Assistant Warden Stacie Ponder. Prior to the search which was conducted by Sergeant Gainnie, Sergeant Gainnie asked Officer Lane if she had anything in her bag she was not supposed to have. Officer Lane stated she did not. Upon searching Officer Lane's property, Sergeant Gainnie discovered a crystalline substance located in feminine hygiene items Officer Lane had in her lunch bag. Captain Tyler stated he conducted a field test, and the substance tested positive for methamphetamine. A chain of custody was initiated, and the evidence was secured in the Temporary Storage Locker (TSL) at Gulf Correctional Institution.

According to Sergeant Gainnie, on April 13, 2018, she conducted a search of Officer Lane in the presence of Captain Tyler, Lieutenant Wilson, and Assistant Warden Ponder. Sergeant Gainnie indicated Officer Lane had a zippered pouch that was located inside her clear lunch bag. Upon opening the pouch, Sergeant Gainnie discovered three (3) feminine hygiene items in the pouch. Sergeant Gainnie noticed two (2) of the feminine hygiene items appeared to have been tampered with. Sergeant Gainnie opened the two (2) which appeared to have been tampered with first and discovered a clear crystalline substance in both items. The third feminine hygiene item did not appear to have been tampered with was also opened and searched and did not contain any contraband items. Sergeant Gainnie turned the evidence over to Captain Tyler and a chain of custody was initiated.

Your Affiant conducted a post-Miranda interview of Officer Lane. Officer Lane stated a search was conducted of her lunch bag upon entrance to the Gulf Correctional Institution Main Unit. During the search, a zippered pouch that was in her lunch bag was opened. Officer Lane stated the zippered pouch contained feminine hygiene items that were hers. Officer Lane indicated the feminine hygiene items were opened and contained a crystalline substance which tested positive for methamphetamine. Officer Lane affirmed she introduced the feminine hygiene items into the institution, but she did not know they contained methamphetamine.

Your Affiant obtained written consent from Officer Lane to search her vehicle, a red Nissan Versa bearing FL Tag# IVXK98. An unsecured Ruger LCP 380 (SN: 371391055) was discovered inside the trunk. No additional items were found.

Your Affiant respectfully submits that probable cause has been established that Officer Cierra Lane did commit the criminal violation of Introduction of Contraband into/onto a State Correctional Institution, in violation of s. 944.47, Fla. Stat., at Gulf Correctional Institution, a state correctional institution located in Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida.
