AFFIDAVIT FOR ARREST

BEFORE ME, David W. King, a Judge of the above captioned court, personally appeared before me Inspector Jared Dewey, who being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

Beginning March 23, 2018, the above named individual, a Correctional Officer with the Florida Department of Corrections, became the subject of an investigation concerning Sexual Misconduct.

On May 8, 2018, Correctional Officer Crystal Royal (*Officer Royal*) was interviewed concerning her involvement in a sexual relationship with Inmate [REDACTED] (*Inmate [REDACTED]* and Inmate [REDACTED] (*Inmate [REDACTED]* Officer Royal was read her Miranda Rights, she waived her rights, and consented to answer questions. Officer Royal was placed under oath and she testifies; she recognizes Inmate [REDACTED] from him working in Food Service, but he was not assigned to work in Food Service. Officer Royal was questioned if she ever went into the Staff Bathroom with Inmate [REDACTED] to which she responds "No sir". Officer Royal denies ever going in the Staff Bathroom alone with Inmate [REDACTED] Officer Royal was adamant nothing happened involving Inmate [REDACTED] and her in the Staff Bathroom, contrary to her previously denying even going into the Staff Bathroom.

Officer Royal was repeatedly reminded about the laws of perjury but she but she continued to deny having any type of relationship with Inmate [REDACTED] and Inmate [REDACTED]

Officer Royal's statements can be contradicted by fixed wing video collected as evidence. The summary of the video review is as follows:


On March 2, 2018 at approximately 1954 hours Inmate [REDACTED] enters the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 1955 hours Officer Royal enters the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 1959 hours Officer Royal exits the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 2001 hours Officer Royal goes back into the Staff Bathroom, where Inmate [REDACTED] remained. At approximately 2010 hours Officer Royal exits the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 2013 hours Inmate [REDACTED] exits the Staff Bathroom.

On March 3, 2018 at approximately 1955 hours Inmate [REDACTED] enters the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 1956 hours Officer Royal enters the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 2009 hours Officer Royal exits the Staff Bathroom. At approximately 2010 hours Inmate [REDACTED] exits the Staff Bathroom.

The criminal investigation was unable to establish if Officer Royal and Inmate [REDACTED] were engaged in any inappropriate relationship, sexual or otherwise.


Based on the video evidence contradicting Officer Royal's sworn testimony, Assistant State Attorney Land (*ASA Land*) was contacted and provided the details of this case. ASA Land did feel there was enough evidence to charge Officer Royal with Perjury not in an Official Proceeding.

WHEREFORE, your affiant prays that an arrest warrant be issued according to law commanding all and singular the Sheriffs of the State of Florida to forthwith arrest the said Crystal Shazette Royal, and bring her before the court to answer the charge of Perjury when not in an Official Proceeding.
