

84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Inspector James K. Maloney of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe that on May 29, 2018, at approximately 8:08 a.m., at Okaloosa Correctional Institution, in Crestview, Okaloosa County, Florida, Inmate Ricardo Bryan, DC# L00414, did batter Correctional Officer [REDACTED] Correctional Officer [REDACTED] and Sergeant [REDACTED]

On May 29, 2018, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a digitally recorded interview of Correctional Officer [REDACTED] (Victim), while at the North Okaloosa Medical Center's Emergency Room #8, which revealed Officer [REDACTED] was conducting callouts after count, while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, at which time Inmate Ricardo Bryan attempted to exit the B-Dormitory, Wing-2, door to go to Legal Mail, however Officer [REDACTED] advised Inmate Bryan not to exit the Dormitory, but eventually he did without permission. Officer [REDACTED] went to Center court and upon arrival, Inmate Bryan stated, "Fuck you" several times to Officer [REDACTED] Correctional Officer [REDACTED] advised Officer [REDACTED] to write Inmate Bryan a Disciplinary Report and to search his bunk. Officer [REDACTED] and Inmate Bryan returned to B-Dormitory and upon arrival, Officer [REDACTED] requested Inmate Bryan to submit to a pat search, but Inmate Bryan refused, began cussing, and advised Officer [REDACTED] that he would, "kick his ass if they were anywhere else." Officer [REDACTED] ordered Inmate Bryan to go to the Sally Port, but he refused. Officer [REDACTED] went back to the Control Room, at which time Correctional Officer [REDACTED] was able to get Inmate Bryan to the Sally Port and began counselling with Inmate Bryan. Inmate Bryan refused to cuff up, became irate, and threatened Officer [REDACTED] that she was going to get what she deserved. Officer [REDACTED] sprayed Inmate Bryan with OC spray, at which time Inmate Bryan picked Officer [REDACTED] up and "slammed" her to the floor. Inmate Bryan picked up the can of OC spray, sprayed Officer [REDACTED] and upon Officer [REDACTED] exiting the Control Room, Inmate Bryan sprayed him in the face/forehead area. Officer [REDACTED] then entered back into the Control Room to radio for help, at which time Inmate Bryan reached around Officer [REDACTED] and sprayed him in the mouth. Officer [REDACTED] advised Inmate Bryan was "swinging" at him, but never struck him. Officer [REDACTED] stated Inmate Bryan also sprayed Officer [REDACTED] as he was entering B-Dormitory to assist with the disturbance.

On May 29, 2018, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a digitally recorded interview of Correctional Officer [REDACTED] (Victim), while at the North Okaloosa Medical Center's Emergency Room #13, which revealed Officer [REDACTED] heard Inmate Bryan state he was going to "fuck up" Officer [REDACTED] Officer [REDACTED] advised she began to counsel with Inmate Bryan and obtained Inmate Bryan's side of the situation. Officer [REDACTED] requested Inmate Bryan to cuff up for both of their safety, so they could speak with the Captain, but Inmate Bryan refused. Inmate Bryan refused Officer [REDACTED] second and third request to cuff up, at which time Officer [REDACTED] removed her OC spray and sprayed Inmate Bryan. Inmate Bryan then crouched down, like a football player, wrapped Officer [REDACTED] around the waist, lifted her off her feet, and then "slammed" her to the floor, on her back. Officer [REDACTED] advised Inmate Bryan punched her, with a closed fist, several times and then grabbed her canister of OC spray, sprayed her and then sprayed other officers.

Your affiant obtained and reviewed the digital video images obtained from the institutional DVR, captured by fixed wing cameras in B-Dormitory, and confirmed on May 29, 2018, at approximately 8:08 a.m., in B-dormitory at Okaloosa Correctional Institution, Inmate Bryan picks Officer [REDACTED] body up off of the floor, raises her body upward and then slams her to the floor. Officer [REDACTED] lands on the floor on her back, with her head bouncing upward off of the floor from the force used by Inmate Bryan. Once Officer [REDACTED] is on the floor, Inmate Bryan strikes Officer [REDACTED] in the face multiple times. Inmate Bryan then takes Officer [REDACTED] state issued canister of [REDACTED] containing Oleoresin-Capsicum (OC) chemical agent and sprays Officer [REDACTED] in her face with the chemical agents. Officer [REDACTED] responds to the hallway at which time Inmate Bryan charges at Officer [REDACTED] raises the [REDACTED] canister of OC chemical agents toward Officer [REDACTED] face and sprays Officer [REDACTED] in the face with the OC chemical agents.

On May 29, 2018, Inspector Darla Henderson conducted a digitally recorded interview of Sergeant [REDACTED] (Victim), while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, which revealed Sergeant [REDACTED] observed Inmate Bryan depart the entrance/exit door of B-Dormitory at Okaloosa Correctional Institution with an [REDACTED] sprav canister containing Oleoresin-Capsicum (OC) chemical agent in his hand. Inmate Bryan charged at Sergeant [REDACTED] pointed the [REDACTED] canister of OC chemical agents in the direction of Sergeant [REDACTED] face and sprayed the chemical agent at Sergeant [REDACTED] striking Sergeant [REDACTED] in the face. Sergeant [REDACTED] further reported witnessing Inmate Bryan raise the [REDACTED] canister of chemical agents at Correctional Officer [REDACTED] and then sprayed Officer [REDACTED] stiking him in the back.

On a May 29, 2018, Inspector Darla Henderson conducted a digitally recorded interview of Correctional Officer [REDACTED] (Victim), while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, which revealed Officer [REDACTED] observed Inmate Bryan running out of B-Dormitory at Okaloosa Correctional institution, holding a [REDACTED] canister of OC chemical agents. Officer [REDACTED] observed Inmate Bryan raise the [REDACTED] canister of OC chemical agents upward, pointing at Officer [REDACTED] face. Officer [REDACTED] turned his body and when Inmate Bryant deployed the chemical agents in the direction of Officer [REDACTED] the chemical agents struck Officer [REDACTED] in his back.

Inmate Bryan was received at Okaloosa Correctional Institution in Crestview, Okaloosa County, Florida, on November 14, 2017, where he remained, uninterrupted, until May 29, 2018.

On May 29, 2018, Inspector Darla Henderson conducted a digitally recorded, Post Miranda, interview of Inmate Ricardo Bryan (Suspect), while at Okaloosa Correctional Institution, in which Inmate Ricardo Bryan, DC# L00414, [REDACTED]

Your Affiant respectfully submits that probable cause has been established that Inmate Ricardo Bryan did, at Okaloosa Correctional Institution, in Crestview, Okaloosa County, Florida, commit the criminal offense of four (4) counts of Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer in violation of F.S.S. 784.07 and one (1) count of Depriving an Officer of Means of Protection in violation of F.S.S. 843.025.
