FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 SHERIFF'S OFFICE FUND 030 BUDGET

Honorable Board of County Commissioners,

The Madison County Sheriff's Office on the 22nd day of June 2018 presented a budget amendment request that was approved for \$63,058,34. A more detailed analysis for the exact cost during our last quarter of fiscal year 2017-2018 should only be amended in the amount of \$54,273.39. This request is to revise the previous approved budget amendment to the reduced amount and further described below. As was the first request this request remains for the Sheriff's Office and the School District to be in compliance with SB 7026 as it relates to school resource officers assigned to schools and to cover salaries, benefits and initial startup costs for the additional SROs at outlying schools in Madison County. The Sheriff's Office has coordinated with the School District and has received an approved SRO contract beginning July 1, 2018 in the amount of \$310,000.00. The largest portion of these funds shall be utilized during the 2018-2019 fiscal year SRO program. The amendment request should be applied as follows:
