Your Affiant is Inspector Scott Gambel with the Office of Inspector General for the Florida Department of Corrections, and the defendant is Shanika Joseph who is assigned to Suwannee Correctional Institution Annex as an Officer. Your affiant has investigated an Introduction of Contraband.

On July 29, 2018, while conducting a cleaning of the search room, at Suwannee Correctional Institution Annex, Officer Ci'era Hopkins found, hidden under a mop in the smaller adjacent search room, 39 cigarettes, 2 grams of K-2, 29 grams of Methamphetamine, and 21 individually wrapped Sub Oxone strips. The Methamphetamine was tested by the Suwannee County Sheriff's Office with positive results.


This search area [REDACTED] upon review, it was discovered that the prior afternoon, July 28, 2018, Officer Joseph entered the search room alone and failed to clear the metal detector. When the metal detector alerted, Officer Joseph can be seen on video walking into the smaller adjacent search room, which is out of view from officers in the control room, for 16 seconds. Officer Joseph again went to the metal detector where it alerted a second time. Officer Joseph again went into the adjacent search room for 58 seconds, during which time Officer Renee Minnich-Higdon exits the control room and enters the large search room, 25 seconds after Officer Joseph went into the smaller search room. Officer Higdon can be heard asking Officer Joseph why she was in there. Officer Joseph comes out of the adjacent search room with her boots in her hand, and again fails to clear the metal detector. It is then discovered by Officer Minnich-Higdon the reason Officer Joseph was not clearing the metal detector was because she was wearing a "smart" watch. Officer Joseph was told this type of watch was not allowed inside the institution, and was given the opportunity to return the watch to her vehicle.

On July 31, 2018, Officer Joseph was interviewed post Miranda at the Inspector General's Office, Suwannee Correctional Institution. Officer Joseph [REDACTED]

Officer Joseph was shown photographs that were taken of the contraband by security staff and identified the contraband in the photographs to be the items she introduced into the institution.

Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established indicating Shanika Joseph did commit the violation of Introduction of Contraband in violation of FSS 944.47, and Possession of a Controlled Substance in violation of FSS 893.13, and Trafficking a Controlled Substance in violation of FSS 893.135 in Suwannee County, Suwannee Correction Institute Annex on July 28, 2018.

All supporting documents referred to in this affidavit will be available for judicial review and will be further explained in your affiant's report of investigation.
