PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT: (specify probable cause for each charge)

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared [REDACTED] who being duly sworn, alleges, on the information and belief, that on the 23rd day of January, 2019, in Marion County, Florida, the defendant did:

Become arrested for the listed charges to wit:

On January 23rd 2019, I, [REDACTED] of the Unified Drug Enforcement Strike Team (U.D.E.S.T.) participated in an undercover operation that involved [REDACTED] acting in an undercover capacity. [REDACTED] had been in telephone contact with co-defendant Kwanzara Angel El Fort over the past several days arranging for a trafficking amount (11 grams) of Oxycodone pills to be introduced into Lowell Correctional Institute. El Fort advised [REDACTED] that she had a connection with a correctional officer (co-defendant William Corbin Bright) at Lowell CI.

On January 23rd, 2019 [REDACTED], El Fort and Bright met at the Loves Truck Stop located at 7791 NW 47th Avenue Ocala, Florida. During the meeting the three agreed for [REDACTED] to provide El Fort with the trafficking amount of Oxycodone pills, El Fort would then provide the pills to Bright and Bright would introduce the pills into Lowell CI. Bright advised that he would require \$500.00 as payment for his services of introducing the pills into the prison.

On that same date, at approximately 3:28 P.M. [REDACTED] met with El Fort at a gas station on 326 and Hwy 441, El Fort then followed [REDACTED] to the Circle K located at Hwy 326 and Jacksonville Rd. While at that Circle K, [REDACTED] provided El Fort with 87 Oxycodone pills and \$500.00. [REDACTED] then watched El Fort walk directly to Bright's vehicle. El Fort entered the passenger seat of Bright's vehicle.

El Fort and Bright were then taken into custody. The \$500.00 was located inside the center console of the vehicle and the pills were located in the floorboard of the vehicle.

The two defendants were then taken to the Ocala Police Department where they were both interviewed. During the interview with El Fort post Miranda, [REDACTED] Post Miranda, after speaking with Bright he gave several different stories in regards to his involvement in the transaction. [REDACTED]

The two were arrested then transported to the Marion County Jail.
