The Undersigned Certifies and swears that he has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following Violation of the law: February 2, 2019, at approximately 3:30  AM  PM (Specially include facts constituting cause for arrest)

Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Inspector Ryan Muse (*Inspector Muse*) with the Office of Inspector General - DC.

On February 2, 2019, at Jefferson Correctional Institution (JCI) in Monticello, Florida, the above-named defendant, Officer Ishwan Spradley (a public servant), knowingly and with intent, committed the criminal offense(s) of: Violation of Authorized Use of Force by a Correctional Officer on an Inmate (malicious battery two counts), and Official Misconduct (one count); when Officer Spradley physically battered Inmates [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and then falsified records pertaining to the incident.

On February 2, 2019, at Jefferson Correctional Institution (JCI), Inmate [REDACTED] reported; he was physically beaten in the [REDACTED] by Officer Spradley on February 2, 2019. Lieutenant Erika Bellamy reviewed the recorded security camera feed footage [REDACTED] which substantiated Inmate [REDACTED] allegations.

On February 7, 2019, Inspector Muse reviewed the video footage showing Officer Spradley alone [REDACTED] having a bag of trash thrown at him through the open doorway, which glanced off his elbow and landed on the ground. Officer Spradley then exits [REDACTED] and forces Inmates [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to enter the [REDACTED]. Officer Spradley shuts the door once all three of them are inside the room and begins to push both inmates multiple times, with no reasonable legal reason to apply force upon either inmate. Officer Spradley appears to strike Inmate [REDACTED] twice, pushes him against the wall (which made him hit his head), and knocks him down into a garbage barrel.

Neither this incident, nor any Use of Force Report was documented by Officer Spradley until he was confronted about the Use of Force by his supervisors. Officer Spradley's Use of Force Report was received and reviewed, with his account of the facts not reflecting those captured on video. It is reasonable to believe Officer Spradley's Use of Force Report was

purposely written as false with his intent being to illegally deceive, minimalize, omit, obstruct and delay, conceal, or negate his actions or involvement in this incident.

Neither Inmates [redacted] nor [redacted] appeared on video to be either combative, nor attempting harm to Officer Spradley during the incident. Both inmates were interviewed with their accounts of the incident matching events captured on video. The touching, pushing, and striking actions conducted by Officer Spradley were both unwanted, and instilled a sense of fear in both victims. Both Inmates [redacted] and [redacted] seek prosecution against Officer Spradley for his actions.

Your affiant respectfully submits, probable cause has been established in that, Officer Spradley committed the criminal violation(s) of; two counts of Violation of Authorized Use of Force by a Correctional Officer on an Inmate, in violation of §944.35(3)(a)(1) Florida State Statute, and one count of Official Misconduct in violation of § 838.022 Florida Statute, at/in Monticello, in Jefferson County, Florida.
