Having received and considered the sworn affidavit of Inspector John Annarumma of the Florida Department of Corrections Office of Inspector General dated June 6 2019, said affidavit alleging:

Count 1: Between approximately November 2018 and March 19, 2019, Megan Benton along with Sandra Hicks and Inmate Everette Hicks conspired to introduce contraband to the Baker Correctional Institution. Megan Benton acted as a conduit for messaging outside legitimate communication avenues between herself, Sandra Hicks and Inmate Everette Hicks, in order to facilitate the introduction of contraband into Baker Correctional Institution (BCI) contrary to Florida State Statute; 777.04(4)(a)(d) Conspiracy.


Counts 2-4: Between approximately November 2018 and March 2019 Megan Benton, at the behest of Inmate Everette Hicks and Sandra Hicks, Introduced Contraband to the Baker Correctional Institution when she purchased tobacco products in the form of cigarettes, processed and packaged them in a manner enabling them to be smuggled inside the Baker Correctional Institution by inserting the contraband into her body cavity. Megan Benton [REDACTED]

Count 5: Between approximately November 2018 and March 2019 Megan Benton was Unlawfully Compensated, when, at the behest of Inmate Everette Hicks and Sandra Hicks, purchased tobacco products in the form of cigarettes, then processed and packaged them in a manner enabling them to be smuggled inside the Baker Correctional Institution once inserted into her body cavity. Megan Benton [REDACTED]

Having received and considered the sworn affidavit of Senior Inspector Justin Bates of the Florida Department of Corrections Office of Inspector General dated June 6 2019, said affidavit alleging:


Count 1: Between approximately November 2018 and March 19, 2019, Sandra Hicks along with Megan Benton and Inmate Everette Hicks conspired to introduce contraband to the Baker Correctional Institution. Sandra Hicks acted as a conduit for messaging outside legitimate communication avenues between herself, Megan Benton and Inmate Everette Hicks, in order to facilitate the introduction of contraband into Baker Correctional Institution (BCI) contrary to Florida State Statute; 777.04(4)(a)(d) Conspiracy.

Count 2: Between approximately November 2018 and March 2019 Sandra Hicks was Unlawfully Compensated, when, at the behest of Inmate Everette Hicks and Megan Benton, she facilitated the movement of money via money orders on behalf of Inmate Everette Hicks from various other inmate's families for payment of services. Sandra Hicks, upon meeting Megan Benton after being searched out and introduced to each other via social media at Everette Hicks request, met in person and persuaded Megan Benton to assist in the introduction of contraband into the Baker Correctional Institution and once completed, compensated Megan Benton \$400 USD cash contrary to Florida State Statute; 838.016(2).

AND HAVING DETERMINED PROBABLE CAUSE TO EXIST FOR SAID CHARGES,

THESE ARE THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU TO FORTHWITH ARREST AND
