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84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector Jerry Basford of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe on August 31, 2018 and September 5, 2018, Correctional Officer Tiffany N. Pearson (Officer Pearson) in the County of Jackson and the State of Florida, did commit the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband into a State Correctional Institution (Communication), in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1) Fla. Stat., when Officer Pearson did actually and intentionally introduce, through unauthorized channels, into the secure perimeter of Apalachee Correctional Institution, electronically transmitted written and/or recorded communication and images to an inmate. Furthermore, Officer Pearson did commit the criminal offense of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of s. 944.39 Fla. Stat., when Officer Pearson engaged in a personal relationship with an inmate under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed the inmate to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections. Lastly, Officer Pearson did commit the criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-way Communication Device, in violation of s. 934.215 Fla. Stat., when Officer Pearson used a cellular telephone to introduce contraband communication to an inmate housed at Apalachee Correctional Institution.

During review of the data contained in a contraband cellular telephone recovered from Apalachee Correctional Institution on November 5, 2018, a contact "Pearson" was identified associated with telephone number [REDACTED]. A text message thread dated August 31, 2018, with contact Pearson, was noted containing two nude images of a black female. In one of the two transmitted images, a tattoo is visible above one breast. The tattoo appears to match Officer Pearson's tattoo, visible in her public social media, of what appears to be a series of Roman numeric characters visible above one of Officer Pearson's breasts.

In the September 5th communication, Officer Pearson indicates the inmate made her mad the night before. Officer Pearson's text message indicates the inmate was smoking with other inmates in the dormitory and attracted the attention of another officer.

Officer Pearson was working on the night of September 4, 2018 and was assigned to P-dormitory.

Sworn testimony was obtained during this investigation from an inmate housed in P-dormitory on September 4, 2018 and identified as a user of the recovered contraband cellular telephone. The inmate confirmed, in a recorded interview, he was communicating with Officer Pearson by text messages and she had sent him images, some of which were unclothed images of herself.

The contraband device contained (209) saved images. The images were reviewed, and two additional images were identified that appear to be Officer Pearson. The images were taken with a cellular telephone in the reflection of what appears to be a bathroom mirror.

Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Tiffany Pearson did commit the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband (Communication), in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1), Florida Statute when Officer Pearson did actually and intentionally introduce through unauthorized channels text messages and images into the secure perimeter of Apalachee Correctional Institution.

Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Tiffany Pearson did commit the criminal violation of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of s. 944.39 Fla. Stat., when Officer Pearson engaged in a personal relationship with an inmate under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed the inmate to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Tiffany Pearson did commit the criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-way Communication Device, in violation of s. 934.215 Fla. Stat., when Officer Pearson used a cellular telephone to introduce contraband communication to an inmate housed at Apalachee Correctional Institution.

You Affiant request an arrest warrant be issued for TIFFANY NICOLE PEARSON, B/F, DOB [REDACTED] LKA [REDACTED] for two counts each of a violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1), the laws related to introducing contraband communication and of s. 934.215, the laws relating to the unlawful use of two-way communication, and for one count of a violation of s. 944.39., the law relating to the interference with the good moral conduct of an inmate.
