AFFIDAVIT FOR ARREST WARRANT

THE STATE OF FLORIDA COUNTY OF ORANGE

BEFORE ME, the undersigned Judge, personally appeared your Affiant, Lead Senior Inspector Mike Wyatt #70914, a member of the Office of Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections, who, by me being first duly sworn, says that on the 18th day of July 2019, in Orange County, Florida, the Defendant, Jestyn Rashard Allen did in violation of section(s) 944.35(3)(a)2 and 92.525(3), Florida Statutes, unlawfully did commit the crime(s) of Malicious Battery with Great Bodily Harm and Perjury by False Declaration.

| On July 18, 2019, at approximately 12:49 pm, Inmate was involved with a use of force with Officer Jestyn Allen while in Transfer and Receiving (T&R) at the Central Florida Reception Center. During the use of force, Officer Allen utilized his chemical agent and deployed it onto Inmate The chemical agent had little to no effect so Officer Allen grabbed Inmate by the upper torso and conducted a leg sweep, redirecting him chest first into a prone position on the ground. Inmate subsequently struck his facial area on the floor. At approximately 12:51 pm, Officer Allen placed hand restraints on Inmate and all forced ceased. The use of force occurred in a hallway adjacent to the holding cells. Inmate |
