NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Inspector James K. Maloney, of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe and does believe that on October 7, 2019, Inmate Steven Sayre, DC #127990, did commit the offense of Battery on Law Enforcement Officer (Correctional Officer) in violation of F.S.S. 784.07(2)(b).

Based on sworn, recorded statements, from the complainant/victims and witnesses, digital video footage, and physical evidence, FLDOC-IG Case 19-17877 was initiated.

In sworn testimony, obtained on October 14, 2019, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a digitally recorded interview of [REDACTED] (Victim 1), while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, which revealed [REDACTED]

In sworn testimony obtained on October 14, 2019, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a digitally recorded interview of [REDACTED] (VICTIM 2), while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, which revealed [REDACTED]

In sworn testimony obtained on October 15, 2019, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a recorded interview of Correctional Sergeant William Goetz, while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, which revealed he responded to B-Dormitory, Wing-2 bathroom, to assist [REDACTED] Sergeant Goetz observed Inmate Sayre acting erratic and several orders were given to submit to restraints. Inmate Sayre refused to go to the sally port or submit to restraints and stated, "Fuck you, I ain't doing nothing you say to do." [REDACTED] administered chemical agents to Inmate Sayre's person, at which time Inmate Sayre "charged" [REDACTED] and kicked him in the knee. Sergeant Goetz observed [REDACTED] attempt to secure Inmate Sayre's feet, as he was kicking and flailing.

In sworn testimony obtained on October 15, 2019, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a digitally recorded interview of Sergeant Jeffrey Nousiainen, while at the Okaloosa Correctional Institution, which revealed he responded to B-Dormitory, Wing-2 bathroom to assist with a disruptive inmate. Sergeant Nousiainen observed Inmate Sayre acting disorderly and refused [REDACTED] orders to stop. [REDACTED] administered chemical agents to Inmate Sayre's person, at which time Inmate Sayre kicked [REDACTED] in the knee. [REDACTED] arrived, assisted with gaining control of Inmate Sayre's legs, and [REDACTED] backed off, holding her shoulder.

A review of the fixed wing camera was conducted by Inspector James K. Maloney on October 11, 2019, which revealed [REDACTED] exited the Wing-2 bathroom holding her right shoulder and wrist.


On October 17, 2019, Inspector James K. Maloney conducted a digitally recorded, post-Miranda, interview of Inmate Steven Sayre, which revealed Inmate Sayre was housed in B-Dormitory, Wing-2 on October 7, 2019, and was in the bathroom smoking. Upon Inmate Sayre's third drag on the cigarette, he felt "high and then the lights went out." Inmate Sayre advised the only other thing he remembered is the smell of Chemical agents.

Your Affiant respectfully submits that probable cause has been established to conclude Inmate Steven Sayre, DC #127990, did commit, on the grounds of Okaloosa Correctional Institution, Okaloosa County, Crestview, Florida, the criminal offense of Battery on Law Enforcement Officer, in violation of F.S.S. 784.07(2)(b) (2 COUNTS).
