The Undersigned Certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following Violation of the law:
 On the 3rd day of March 2020 at 8:50 AM PM (Specially include facts constituting cause for arrest)

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector Chip Potter with the Office of Inspector General for the Florida Department of Corrections, and the defendants are Sergeants Ethan Burkett (*Sergeant Burkett*), Coty Wiltgen (*Sergeant Wiltgen*), and Officer William Shackelford (*Officer Shackelford*) who are currently certified FDC Correctional Employees assigned to Hamilton Correctional Institution (*HCI*). Your affiant has investigated a Malicious Battery case whereas the three listed officers brutally beat Inmate [REDACTED] (*Inmate [REDACTED]*) DC# [REDACTED] while Inmate [REDACTED] was housed at HCI.

On March 03, 2020, staff including Sergeants Wiltgen, Burkett, and Officer Shackelford entered G-dorm to conduct searches of inmate cells. An inmate broke and ran through the dorm and Sergeant Burkett gave chase. Inmate [REDACTED] was in the middle of the common area when the running inmate passed him. As Sergeant Burkett attempted to pass Inmate [REDACTED] Inmate [REDACTED] pushed him off his path resulting in Sergeant Wiltgen utilizing chemical agents on Inmate [REDACTED]. As chemical agents were being administered Inmate [REDACTED] walked calmly away from Sergeant Wiltgen and laid down on the floor showing no signs of resistance. Sergeant Wiltgen applied hand restraints to Inmate [REDACTED] securing his hands behind his back. Sergeant Wiltgen assisted by Officer Shackelford escorted Inmate [REDACTED] out of the dorm. All of the previously described activity was captured on fixed wing video. At no time after being sprayed with chemical agents did Inmate [REDACTED] show any further signs of aggression or resistance. He walked cooperatively with officers out of the dorm and out of camera view.

Your affiant has secured inmate and staff testimony supporting the kicking and punching of Inmate [REDACTED] by Sergeants Wiltgen and Burkett, as well as Officer Shackelford. Witnesses testified they were in proximity to observe the actions of Inmate [REDACTED], Sergeants Wiltgen, Burkett and Officer Shackelford and stated Inmate [REDACTED] offered no resistance while being kicked and punched by Sergeants Wiltgen, Burkett and Officer Shackelford. Once on hand held camera, it was very evident by this writer Inmate [REDACTED] were not caused by being placed chest first on the ground, subsequently striking his head and face on the corner of the sidewalk, as was documented in Sergeant Wiltgen's UOF report and incident report, as well as Officer Shackelford's incident report. [REDACTED]

In Officer Shackelford's Incident Report, he writes he observed Inmate [REDACTED] become combative and attempt to head butt Sergeant Wiltgen, so Sergeant Wiltgen forced Inmate [REDACTED] to the ground, inadvertently striking his head and facial area on the corner of the pavement. Once on the ground Inmate [REDACTED] became compliant. He writes he did not utilize any force during this incident and witnessed only the minimal amount of force necessary to over come resistance. Inmate [REDACTED] the explanation in Officer Shackelford's Incident Report and is contradictory to what witnesses have testified too, witnessing him hitting and kicking Inmate [REDACTED]

Based on victim testimony, as well as witness and video evidence, your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established Officer William Shackelford did commit the offenses, one (1) count of Malicious Battery against an Inmate in violation of 944.35(3)(a)2, and one (1) count Official Misconduct in violation of FSS 838.022(1)(a) in Hamilton County, Florida, Hamilton Correctional Institution on March 03, 2020.

All supporting documents referred to in this affidavit will be available for judicial review and will be further explained in your affiant's report of investigation.
