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84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Inspector Stacy L. Harris with the Florida Department of Corrections, Office of the Inspector General. Your Affiant has probable cause to believe that between October 30, 2019 and January 18, 2020, at Santa Rosa Correctional Institution - Annex, 5850 E. Milton Road, Milton, Santa Rosa County, Florida, Angela L. Howington, did commit the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband into a State Correctional Institution, in violation of s. 944.47(1)(a)(1) Fla. Stat., when Ms. Howington did actually and intentionally transmit digitally written and recorded communications into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution to an inmate identified as Inmate Christopher Arnold, DC #P17407. Further, Ms. Howington did commit the criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-Way Communications Device in violation of s. 934.215 Fla. Stat., when Ms. Howington did actually and intentionally utilize a cellular telephone to transmit digitally written and recorded communications to the contraband cellular device seized during a mass search on February 3, 2020 from M – Dormitory, a secured housing unit within the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution.

On February 3, 2020 a mass search of secured housing unit M – Dormitory was conducted by K9 Captain Daniel Carmical, Florida Department of Corrections. Captain Carmical discovered two cellular telephones, wrapped in cellophane, in the mop closet of the Wing 1 bathroom of M – Dormitory. One cellular device was an Alcatel smartphone and one cellular device was a black, LG smartphone. Between the two cellular telephones was the identification card of Inmate Joseph Evans, DC #U22090. The cellular devices were sent to the Florida Department of Corrections, Office of the Inspector General's cellular telephone laboratory for analysis. On March 3, 2020 a Cellbrite Extraction report was generated of the information contained in the Alcatel smartphone, IMEI #01502600385911, and SIM Card #89014103270784591893, which revealed text message communications between the contraband cellular device and the telephone number (850) 860-6589, which was identified as the personal contact cellular telephone of Angela Howington, as provided by Ms. Howington in email communication to Your Affiant, and confirmed by investigative sources.

Call logs from the extraction report indicated the following text message exchanges:

A text from Ms. Howington's cell on 10/30/2019 at 1902 hours read: "And what she think you owe him that much you ain't eve"

At 1903 hours, a second text read: "Sorry babe my phone is stupid tried to call anybody who's in my phone now"

At 1908 hours, a third text read: "And I guess I could get him to wait and give you time on it but he want some pussy and exchange so you tell me what to do and yeah I'm upset not to I don't like the way you just talk to me"

A text to Ms. Howington's cell on 1/12/2020 at 2139 hours read: "Please remember don't by that card"

A text from Ms. Howington's cell in response at 2220 hours read: "I won't but call me and explain."

A text from Ms. Howington's cell on 1/13/2020 at 2109 hours read: "Ok. It's sent and it shows it's been accepted"

A text from Ms. Howington's cell on 1/18/2020 at 2322 hours read: "I'm sorry to bother you but I must speak with my man right away on business. Would you mind very much plz letting him call or text me real quick. If you can thank you and if you can't I apologize for bothering you"

At 2253 hours on the same date, the above text was sent again from Ms. Howington's cell.

On May 4, 2020 Your Affiant attempted to obtain a sworn, post Miranda statement from Ms. Howington; however, Ms. Howington indicated she was not able to provide a statement at that time. On May 5, 2020 Your Affiant received an email from Ms. Howington who again declined to provide a statement.

our Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established to conclude Angela Howington did commit the criminal violation of Introduction of Contraband into a State Correctional Institution, in violation of s. 944.47(1)(a)(1) Florida Statute, when she did actually and intentionally transmit digitally written, and recorded communications into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution to a contraband cellular device discovered inside the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution. Your Affiant further submits probable cause has been established Angela Howington did commit the criminal violation of Unlawful Use of a Two-Way Communications Device, in violation of s. 934.215 Florida Statute when Angela Howington did actually and intentionally utilize a cellular telephone to unlawfully transmit digitally written and recorded communications to an inmate who was housed within the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution.
