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B4 NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violation of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Inspector Stacy L. Harris with the Florida Department of Corrections, Office of the Inspector General. Your Affiant has probable cause to believe and does believe on May 6, 2020, at Santa Rosa Correctional Institution, 5850 E. Milton Rd., Milton, Santa Rosa County, Florida, Inmate Juan C. Langley, DC #982926, an inmate housed at a State Correctional Institution, did violate Florida State Statute 784.07(2)(b).

On May 6, 2020, at approximately 2:30 p.m., members of a cell extraction team entered the cell of Inmate Langley due to his refusal to comply with lawful orders to submit to hand restraints and exit his cell. As team members entered the cell, Inmate Langley attacked Correctional Officer [REDACTED] intentionally [REDACTED] to their persons.

Your Affiant obtained a sworn, recorded victim statement from [REDACTED] who indicated [REDACTED]

Senior Inspector James Baxley obtained a sworn, recorded victim statement from [REDACTED] who indicated [REDACTED]

Your Affiant obtained a sworn, recorded witness statement from Officer Jason Bishop who indicated he was a member of the cell extraction team, who served as the "shield man" responsible for pinning Inmate Langley against a wall in order for other team members to secure him in restraints. Inmate Langley was positioned between the toilet and the bottom of the bunk as the team entered the cell. As Officer Bishop attempted to pin Inmate Langley to the wall with the plexiglass shield, Officer Bishop slid to the right, which gave Inmate Langley an opening over the top of the shield where Inmate Langley used his closed fists to strike [REDACTED] several times in the facial area. Officer Bishop indicated they were able to get Inmate Langley down on the lower bunk where he observed Inmate Langley "up close, had his hand right at [REDACTED] eyes." Officer Bishop observed Inmate Langley tried to put his thumb in [REDACTED] eye. Officer Bishop witnessed Inmate Langley punch [REDACTED] right up under the face shield of the helmet." Once Inmate Langley was secured in restraints, Officer Bishop assisted in escorting Inmate Langley to G – Dormitory for a [REDACTED] and while walking [REDACTED] Inmate Langley continued to make threats to staff by saying, "I'll beat you all. I'll take you on one on one," and "a bunch of swear words."

Your Affiant obtained a sworn, recorded witness statement from Captain Joseph Schrock, the Shift Supervisor, who indicated he ordered Inmate Langley to submit to hand restraints because Inmate Langley refused to remove his arm from the hand cuffing portal in order to have his cell secured. Captain Schrock received authorization to move Inmate Langley to another cell which had a heightened security hand cuffing portal which would prevent Inmate Langley from this obstruction in the future. Inmate Langley refused all orders to submit to hand restraints. Captain Schrock checked [REDACTED] and it was determined chemical agents could not be administered to Inmate Langley, therefore Captain Schrock received authorization to utilize a cell extraction team to bring Inmate Langley into compliance with lawful orders. Captain Schrock assisted in opening the cell door for the extraction team to enter, at which time he observed Inmate Langley strike [REDACTED] with closed fists several times in the head, facial area and upper torso. After Inmate Langley was secured in restraints and the extraction team exited the cell, Captain Schrock observed [REDACTED] which were not there prior to [REDACTED] entry into the cell; [REDACTED] which were not there prior to [REDACTED] entry into the cell; and

[redacted] which were not there prior to [redacted] entry into the cell. As inmate Langley was  
inmate Langley continued to make physical threats of harm to staff.

This incident was also recorded on a hand held video recording device.

Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause, based on victim and witness statements, as well as video footage, has been established to conclude inmate Juan Langley, DC #982926, did commit the criminal violation of Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer (3 Counts), in violation of F.S.S. Chapter 784.07(2)(b) when he intentionally struck, with closed fists, [redacted] Correctional Officer [redacted] on duty in the performance of official duties, on May 6, 2020, while housed at Santa Rosa Correctional Institution, Milton, Florida, Santa Rosa County, Florida.
