ROCKELLE M. SANDERS, on or about August 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, committed the offense of Introduction of Contraband into a State Correctional Institution (Communication) contrary to Florida Statutes 944.47 (1)(a)(1) (3 DEG FELONY), and

ROCKELLE M. SANDERS, in or about August 2020, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, committed the offense of Introduction of Contraband into a State Correctional Institution (Communication) contrary to Florida Statutes 944.47 (1)(a)(I) (3 DEG FELONY), and

ROCKELLE M. SANDERS, on or about August 26, 2020, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, committed the offense of Unlawful use of a two-way communication device contrary to Florida Statutes 934.215 (3 DEG FELONY), and

ROCKELLE M. SANDERS, in or about August 2020, in the County of Jackson and State of Florida, committed the offense of Interference with prisoners, contrary to Florida Statutes 944.39 (1 DEG MISD)

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector Jerry Basford of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Cometting

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe Correctional Officer Rockells Sanders ("Officer Sanders"), in the County of Jackson and the State of Florida, did commit two criminal offenses of Introduction of Contraband into a State Correctional Institution (Communication), in violation of a. 944.47 [1](a)[1] Florida Statute, when Officer Sanders did actually and intentionally introduce, through unauthorized channels, into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution, electronically transmitted and handwritten and/or recorded communication to an inmate. Probable cause also exists Officer Sanders did commit an additional criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-way Communication Device, in violation of a. 934.216 Florida Statute, when Officer Sanders used an electronic communication device to introduce contraband communication to an inmate housed within a State Correctional Institution. Lastly, Officer Sanders committed the criminal offense of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of a. 944.39 Florida Statute, when Officer Sanders engaged in a personal relationship with an inmate under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed the inmate to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections.

Officer Sanders began her employment with the Florida Department of Corrections on or about January 10, 2020, as a correctional officer training working at Graceville Work Camp. As part of her initial training, Officer Sanders underwent orientation and field training during which she was warned about inmote menipulation and the consequences of inappropriate relationships with immates.

Officer Sandars attended correctional officer back recruit training beginning on February 17, 2020, through August 28, 2020, the date of her resignation as a correctional officer. Officer Sandars did not take the State Board prior to the discovery of an imperprepriate relationship occurring between her and immate Steven Parez-Nievas, DCS C07153.

Suspicion of Officer Sander's inappropriate relationship with an immate began on or about August 12, 2020, when a mostly indiscernible, yet inappropriate sounding conversation was overheard between Officer Sanders and an unidentified inmate. Officer Sanders later admitted the conversation was with immate Perez.

On August 28, 2020, Correctional Officer Sergeant Aaron Kirkland was reviewing electronic correspondences on J-pay, an electric email-like platform used by immates and their family and associates to communicate. The use of J-pay by staff to communicate with immates is not permitted unless prior notification and approval is received by institutional administration.

Sergeant Kirkland identified a newly created suspicious account communicating with inmate Perez. Given the prior intelligence, Sergeant Kirkland interviewed inmate Perez who admitted the account was Officer Sanders' account.

Officer Sanders submitted her resignation on August 28, 2020, due to her inappropriate relationship with inmate Porez.

Following her resignation, inspector William Dalton contacted Officer Sanders who agreed to return to Jackson Correctional Institution and speak with him about inmate Perez. Officer Sanders provided inspector Dalton with a non-custodial sworn interview related to the allegations against her.



A review of J-pay account 26305365 indicates inmate Perez sent Officer Sandars five electronic letters, four of which occurred while she was still employed as a correctional officer at Graceville Work Gamp. Your Afflant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Rockelle Sanders did commit the criminal offense of introduction of Contraband (Communication), in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(s)(1), Florida Statute, when Officer Sanders did actually and intentionally introduce through unauthorized channels, electronically transmitted written and/or recorded communication to an inmate, within the secure perimeter of a State Correctional institution using J-pay, a means not approved for staff communication with immates. Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Rockella Sanders did commit the criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-way Communication Device, in violation of s. 934.215 Fiorida Statute, when Officer Sanders used an electronic communication device to introduce electronic contraband communication to an inmate housed within a State Correctional Institution. Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Rockelle Sanders did commit the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband (Communication), in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1), Florida Statute, when Officer Sanders did actually and intentionally introduce through unauthorized channels, a handwritten letter and drawing to an immate, within the secure parimeter of a State Correctional Institution. Your Affiant respectfully submits probable cause has been established that Correctional Officer Rockelle Sanders did commit the eriminal violation of interference with Prisoners, in violation of s. 944.39 Florida Statute, when Officer Sanders engaged in a romantic personal relationship with an immate under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed the inmate to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections. Your Affiant requests an arrest warrant be issued for ROCKELLE SANDERS, DOB , for two counts of a violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1), the laws related introducing contraband communication; one count of a violation of s. 934.215, the laws related to the unlawful use of two-way communication; and one count of a violation of s. 944.39 the laws related to the interference with prisoners. 86.
