

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

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84. NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector Jerry Basford of the Office of the Inspector General ("OIG"), Florida Department of Corrections (FDC).

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe between March 2020 and March 2021, Correctional Officer Samantha Boykin ("Officer Boykin") in the County of Washington and the State of Florida, did commit (50) counts of the criminal offense of Unlawful Compensation or Reward for Official Behavior in violation of s. 838.016 Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin did actually and intentionally receive fifty separate electronic money transfers to personally benefit Officer Boykin, for the nonperformance of her lawful duty as a certified correctional officer, to wit: the overlooking, permitting, an/or enabling the violation of Florida criminal laws and the Departmental disciplinary rules. In addition, Officer Boykin did commit four counts of the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband (Written Communication) in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1) Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin did actually and intentionally introduce, through unauthorized channels, into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution, electronically transmitted and/or recorded written communication to multiple inmates and an additional two counts of a violation of the same statute when Officer Boykin did actually and intentionally introduce, through unauthorized channels, into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution, electronically transmitted and/or recorded digital images to multiple inmates. Probable cause also exists Officer Boykin did commit six counts of the criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-way Communication Device, in violation of s. 934.215 Florida Statute., when Officer Boykin used an electronic communication device to introduce contraband communication and digital images to inmates housed within a State Correctional Institution. Lastly, Officer Boykin committed eight counts of the criminal offense of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of s. 944.39 Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin engaged in a personal relationship with eight separate inmates under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed the inmate to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections.

Officer Boykin began her career with the Florida Department of Corrections in or about August 2018 as a correctional officer trainee at Northwest Florida Reception Center Annex ("NWFRCA"). From October 2018 through February 2019, Officer Boykin attended Basic Recruit Training to become a certified correctional officer. During Officer Boykin's employment, she has worked at NWFRCA in various assignments since becoming a certified officer.

In October 2020, sworn testimony was obtained from an inmate housed at NWFRCA indicating Officer Boykin was responsible for introducing contraband cellular telephones, drugs, and most anything else an inmate wanted into NWFRCA in exchange for monetary compensation. The inmate witness testified he sent Officer Boykin \$600.00 via Cash App as payment for Officer Boykin to smuggle one pound of marijuana into the facility. The marijuana was sent to Officer Boykin at no cost to her and the payment was for merely introducing the drug. Officer Boykin successfully smuggled the marijuana into NWFRCA over a period of two or three weeks. The inmate could not provide Officer Boykin's specific Cash App information, but indicated it was associated with her personal telephone number and included the word "cherry."

Officer Boykin's personal cellular telephone number on file with the Florida Department of Corrections (██████████) was queried in Cash App and an account identified using the "cash tag" \$MZCHERRYLUV. Subpoenas duces tecum were issued and served to Square Inc., the parent company for Cash App, requesting account information for the account associated with cash tag \$MZCHERRYLUV and for account information for the accounts completing transactions with the suspect account.

According to Square Inc., cash tag \$MZCHERRYLUV is associated with Officer Boykin. The account holder information provided by Square Inc. matches Officer Boykin's information on file with the Florida Department of Corrections.

While reviewing accounts sending money transfers to Officer Boykin, five accounts were identified associated with inmates and/or the associates of the inmates who were all housed at NWFRCA when the money transfers were sent and while Officer Boykin was employed as a correctional officer at the facility.

Two accounts identified by display names "Elite" and "Loyalty" respectively, belong to Inmate Samuel Johnson's (493847) son, Samuel Johnson Jr. The account holder identification was made through comparison of the information provided by Square Inc. and the visitor profile biographical information for Inmate Johnson's son. According to Square records, Inmate Johnson's son sent Officer Boykin eleven separate money transfers between March 2020 and August 2020 using cash tag "Elite" totaling \$4475.00. An additional five transfers were sent using cash tag "Loyalty" totaling \$5400.00.

A third Cash App account, identified by display name "Michael Trimuar," belongs to Inmate Michael Trimuar, DC# P11082. The account holder identification was made through comparison of the information provided by Square Inc. and Inmate Trimuar's biographical information. Inmate Trimuar sent Officer Boykin a single money transfer on January 23, 2021 for \$1170.00 including a memo, "car note." Inmate Trimuar was housed at NWFRCA at the time he sent the money transfer to Officer Boykin.

A fourth Cash App account, identified by display name "D.B. Cooper," belongs to Inmate Bryan Youtes, DC# P40297. The account holder identification was made through comparison of the information provided by Square Inc. and Inmate Youtes' biographical information. Between May 19, 2020 and March 30, 2021, Inmate Youtes sent Officer Boykin (31) cash app money transfers totaling \$7866.00. Inmate Youtes' transfers include various memos, some of which indicating Inmate Youtes is providing money to Officer Boykin for her personal living expenses such as rent, day care, storage, and telephone bills, while other memos indicate the payment is for shopping, hair, and manicures. Some memos indicate the payments are for particular items including Galaxy ear buds and a vacuum packer.

A fifth Cash App account, identified by display name "Marcus," belongs to former Inmate Marcus Barnes, DC# U04755. The account holder information was made through comparison of the information provided by Square Inc. and former Inmate Barnes' biographical information. Former Inmate Barnes was released from the Florida Department of Corrections before Officer Boykin began her employment with the agency. A J-pay account for former Inmate Barnes was identified exchanging email correspondences and videos with Inmate Andre Jackson, DC# R78658. Former Inmate Barnes sent two money transfers to Officer Boykin in December 2020 totaling \$500.00. Inmate Jackson was housed at NWFRC-A at the time former Inmate Barnes sent Officer Boykin money. It is evident through their J-pay communication, former Inmate Barnes and Inmate Jackson are associates.

Through experience in conducting similar investigations, your Affiant has knowledge inmates housed in the Florida Department of Corrections often maintain and operate their own Cash App accounts using contraband cellular telephones. The inmate maintained Cash App accounts are linked to typical bank accounts often opened with assistance of the inmates' friends, family, and/or associates.

J-pay is an online platform contracted by the Florida Department of Corrections for inmates to communicate with their family, friends and associates through electronic mail messages, image transfers and video transfers. Another function of J-pay is to provide a platform for inmates' family, friends and associates to send the inmates money for use in canteen and other expenditures. The use of J-pay by staff to communicate with inmates is strictly prohibited, except in circumstances where the staff member seeks and is granted approval by their command staff. This exception is generally the case when the staff member has a close family member incarcerated in the agency.

As part of this investigation, J-pay was reviewed, and various queries were made related to information obtained during the investigation. Four fraudulent J-pay accounts were identified associated with Officer Boykin.

Account [REDACTED] identified in the name "Sharisse Lynn," was created on February 27, 2019. Social media indicates Sharisse Lynn is likely Officer Boykin's sister. As of May 2021, the Sharisse Lynn account sent (213) messages and received (422) messages. The Sharisse Lynn account has communicated with two inmates both housed at NWFRC-A during Officer Boykin's employment. Although a few messages were sent to Inmate Tavaris Jones, DC# R58188, the primary inmate communicating with Officer Boykin on this account is Jorge Malpaca, DC# T60333. During correspondence with Officer Boykin, Inmate Malpaca addresses Officer Boykin on one occasion as "Sam," (Officer Boykin's first name is Samantha) and wishes Officer Boykin a happy birthday on [REDACTED] (Officer Boykin's actual date of birth). Officer Boykin and Inmate Malpaca's conversations are often sexually graphic and indicate the two are or have been in a romantic relationship. On one occasion Officer Boykin sent Inmate Malpaca an image that, although no facial depiction is included, is of similar stature and appearance to herself. During the exchange of communication on the Sharisee Lynn account, a static IP address (68.62.197.235) owned by Comcast Cable Communications, Inc. was identified. J-pay was queried for other account using the same IP address resulting in the discovery of three other fraudulent accounts.

Account [REDACTED] identified in the name "Hailey Arrieta," was created on October 21, 2020. The Hailey Arrieta account used the same static IP address (68.62.197.235) when sending messages. The Hailey Arrieta account communicated solely with Inmate Juan Arrieta-Rolon, DC# D05700, sending eight messages and receiving (16). Inmate Arrieta-Rolon was housed at NWFRC-A between October 2018 and December 2020 where Officer Boykin is employed.

Account [REDACTED] identified in the name "Shania Cole," was created on September 22, 2019. The Shania Cole account was used to exchange communication with Inmate Alvin King, DC# 130121. The Shania Cole account used the same static IP address (68.62.197.235) when sending messages. Between September 2019 and December 2019, Officer Boykin sent (108) messages to Inmate King and received (131) messages from Inmate King via the Shania Cole account. Officer Boykin sent five images to Inmate King. Three images are of a female of the same physical appearance as Officer Boykin. Two of the three images have no facial depiction. The third image includes a partial facial depiction of the female who is wearing the same clothing as the picture sent to Inmate Malpaca using the Shariss Lynn account. The image appears to be taken in a bathroom setting in front of what appears to be the same shower curtain as the image to Inmate Malpaca. The partial facial depiction includes the lower portion of the person's face, lips, and chin. It is the opinion of your Affiant the person in the image sent to Inmate King is Officer Boykin based on your Affiant's review of Officer Boykin's staff identification picture, social media images, and your Affiant's professional contact with Officer Boykin.

Account [REDACTED] identified in the name "Snowey Youtes," was created on December 17, 2020. Officer Boykin used the Snowey Youtes account to exchange communication with Inmate Andre Jackson, DC# R78658 and Inmate Brian Youtes, DC# P40297. The Snowey Youtes account used the same static IP address (68.62.197.235) when sending messages. Between December 2020 and May 2021, Officer Boykin sent (53) messages and received (65) messages using the Snowey Youtes account. Officer Boykin received Cash App money transfers from Inmate Jackson and Inmate Youtes.

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Subpoena duces tecum was issued and served to Comcast Cable Communications Inc. requesting subscriber information related to IP address 68.62.197.235. According to Comcast records, the IP address is associated with an account subscribed to by Samantha Boykin. The service address, billing address, and telephone number on the Comcast account is the same information on file with the Florida Department of Corrections for Officer Boykin.

Based on the evidence compiled in this investigation and summarized in this affidavit, your Affiant submits probable cause is established that the defendant, CORRECTIONAL OFFICER SAMANTHA BOYKIN, engaged in personal business and/or romantic relationships with eight inmates. While engaged in those relationships, Officer Boykin created and used four separate fraudulent J-pay accounts to send and receive both written communication and digital images with six separate inmates, two of which are responsible for money transfers received by Officer Boykin. As part of her relationships with inmates, Officer Boykin has received (50) Cash App money transfers totaling approximately \$19,411.00 as payment for various services, items, and acts, but all to personally benefit Officer Boykin. If not for Officer Boykin's failure to perform her lawful public duties as a correctional officer as outlined in Florida Statute, Florida Administrative Code, and the Florida Department of Corrections Employee Handbook, specifically related to Staff/Inmate/Offender Relationships, Officer Boykin would not have been personally compensated directly by inmates and/or their associates. During the commission of the aforementioned crimes, Officer Boykin has repeatedly permitted and continuously overlooked numerous violations of Florida Department of Corrections Policies, Florida Administrative Code, and Florida Statutes by inmates under her supervision and while doing so interfered with the discipline and good conduct of at least eight separate inmates.

Your Affiant submits probable cause has been established between March 2020 and March 2021, Correctional Officer Samantha Boykin in the County of Washington and the State of Florida, did commit (50) counts of the criminal offense of Unlawful Compensation or Reward for Official Behavior in violation of s. 838.016 Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin did actually and intentionally receive fifty separate electronic money transfers to personally benefit Officer Boykin, for the nonperformance of her lawful duty as a certified correctional officer, to wit: the overlooking, permitting, an/or enabling the violation of Florida criminal laws and the Departmental disciplinary rules.

Your Affiant submits probable cause has been established between September 2019 and May 2021, Correctional Officer Samantha Boykin did commit four counts of the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband (Written Communication) in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1) Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin did actually and intentionally introduce, through unauthorized channels, into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution, electronically transmitted and/or recorded written communication to inmates using J-pay accounts [REDACTED]

Your Affiant submits probable cause has been established between September 2019 and May 2021, Correctional Officer Samantha Boykin did commit an additional two counts of the criminal offense of Introduction of Contraband (Digital Images) in violation of s. 944.47 (1)(a)(1) Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin did actually and intentionally introduce, through unauthorized channels, into the secure perimeter of a State Correctional Institution, electronically transmitted and/or recorded digital images to inmates using J-pay accounts [REDACTED]


You Affiant submits probable cause has been established between September 2019 and May 2021, Correctional Officer Samantha Boykin did commit six counts of the criminal offense of Unlawful Use of a Two-way Communication Device, in violation of s. 934.215 Florida Statute, when Officer Boykin used an electronic communication device to introduce contraband communication (Written communication and digital images) to inmates housed within a State Correctional Institution.


You Affiant submits probable cause has been established between September 2019 and May 2021, Correctional Officer Samantha Boykin committed eight counts of the criminal offense of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of s. 944.39 Fla. Stat., when Officer Boykin engaged in a personal business and/or romantic relationship with Inmate Johnson, Inmate Trimuar, Inmate Youtes, Inmate Jackson, Inmate King, Inmate Jones, Inmate Malpaca, and Inmate Arrieta-Rolon while they were under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections, and while doing so allowed the inmates to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant requests an arrest warrant be issued for SAMANTHA BOYKIN, DOB [REDACTED] LKA [REDACTED] [REDACTED], for (50) counts of a violation of 838.016, the law relating to Unlawful compensation or reward for official behavior; six counts of a violation of 944.47(1)(a)(1), the law relating to introduction of contraband, written or recorded communication; six counts of a violation of 934.215, the law relating to Unlawful use of a two-way communication device, an eight counts of a violation of 944.39, the law relating to Interference with prisoners.

WARRANT FOR ARREST

IN THE 14th JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT IN AND FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY, FLORIDA


